Code of Conduct for Parents / Carers

All Parents/Carers also have a major role to play in supporting their child's involvement and in helping them to enjoy their sport. All adults should adhere to the codes of conduct for parents/carers as advised below;

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognizing fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgments.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times

Colts Players Code of Conduct

- Colts must exercise proper respect to all club members, visitors, and opponents
- Colts must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Colts must always exercise sportsmanship in the true spirit of cricket.
- Colts must keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Colts must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Junior Colts are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior Colts are not allowed to consume alcohol of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.

(Junior in this context means beneath the legal age limit.)
